Achievement and progress

Accelerated progress

In Reception, children settle quickly and make very good progress – the percentage of children on track in their learning has exceeded local and national averages for the past four years.

Our 2014 Key Stage 2 results put Cabot in the top 14% for progress across the country.

Strong performance

The impact of high quality teaching is reflected in achievement of pupils from all backgrounds – Cabot pupils are among the highest performers in the area.

In 2015, 80% of our pupils achieved level 4 in Reading, Writing and Maths combined.

Celebrating achievement

Every achievement is valued at Cabot. We have fantastic readers, writers, mathematicians, musicians, artists, school councillors and sports stars.

We all share in each other's success as we strive to live the school vision, 'Learn Together, Respect Each other and Achieve Forever.

Enriched learning

We aim to create inspiring and interesting learning opportunities across the school and have created exciting new spaces to support enrichment opportunities.

Excellent facilities

Our outdoor Science Garden is a firm favourite with pupils, combining investigative opportunities with fun, play and discovery.

Indoors, we have a spacious ICT suite and every class has its own interactive whiteboard.

We have a well-equipped food technology suite, designed

specifically for learning activities, plus an art room, studio room, music room, and access to a modern and inviting library.

After school provision

A welcome space for after-school clubs is our studio room, which allows us to provide extended after-school provision until 5.30pm for working parents.

Specialist partnerships

Cabot works in partnership with specialist providers – music teachers, professional sports coaches, engineers, and acclaimed writers like Pie Corbett, to enrich pupil learning.
